Mr. Lieberman is co-author of *School Crisis Prevention: the PREPaRE Model* and Best Practices in Suicide Intervention (IV & V). He has written numerous book chapters and articles on youth suicide prevention, crisis intervention and responding to self-injurious students in the schools. Mr. Lieberman serves on the Steering Committee for the national Suicide Prevention Resource Center and two task forces of the National Action Alliance for Suicide Prevention.
