**Strategies for Supporting LGBTQ Youth in Schools**

**This workshop will cover a range of topics related to supporting lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, and questioning (LGBTQ) students in school settings. Dr. Kennedy will cover risk and protective factors, legal issues, counseling strategies for working directly with LGBTQ youth and parents, and identifying community-based resources. Dr. Kennedy is an assistant professor in the counseling and school psychology programs at Chapman University. Her scholarly interests include culturally competent practice, resilience, and best practices for supporting LGBTQ students in school settings. Dr. Kennedy is the editor of the Trainers in School Psychology Trainer's Forum, an associate editor of Contemporary School Psychology, and also recently co-authored a book on school-based supports for LGBTQ students.
